The regular meeting of the Blevins School Board was called to order by President Melony Ford on Monday, September 12, 2011 in the administration office. Board members present: Laura Clark, Tim Estes, Melony Ford, Carl McGill, Paul Noesser, Jimmy Rhodes, and Richard Snell. Minutes to the August 8, 2011 meeting were approved as presented.

Tim Estes made a motion to accept the financial report as read. The motion passed with a vote of 7-0.

Tim Estes made a motion to accept the 2011-2012 budget. Motion passed with a 7-0 vote.

Tim Estes made a motion to accept the 2011-2012 Special Education budget. Motion passed with a 7-0 vote.

Tim Estes made a motion to approve the 2011-2012 ACSIP plans, assurance statements, and 2011-2012 federal budget. Motion passed with a vote of 7-0.

Tim Estes made a motion to adjust the amount the district pays per person for health insurance from \$145 to \$131 monthly. Motion passed with a 7-0 vote.

Paul Noesser made a motion to put money for a \$100,000 CD in the Bank of Prescott at 1.15%. The motion passed with a vote of 7-0.

Paul Noesser made a motion to accept the 2011-2012 ALE tuition agreement with Garland in Hope in the amount of \$4377.32. Motion passed with a vote of 7-0.

Tim Estes made a motion to renew the ASBA model policy at \$950. The motion passed with a 7-0 vote.

Richard Snell made a motion to approve all revised ASBA policies for the 2011-2012 school year. Motion passed with 7-0 vote.

Tim Estes made a motion to accept a bid from McKinnon for \$3180 to deliver and spread gravel at the bus shop. Motion passed with a 7-0 vote.

Paul Noesser made a motion for David Stallworth to paint and install bleacher seats in the high school gym. Motion passed with a vote of 7-0.

Melony Ford made a motion to sell the old school car and assorted metal on campus for scrap with proceeds to go to the transportation fund. Motion passed with a 7-0 vote.

Board President Melony Ford called for an executive session at 8:35p.m. The board meeting resumed at 8:50 p.m.

Jimmy Rhodes made a motion to pay McKinnon \$80/hour for bulldozer work on a lot owned by the school district located next to the campus for use as a softball field and outdoor educational area. Motion passed with a vote of 7-0.
