

Blevins School Board Meeting

December 9, 2013

The regular meeting of the Blevins School Board was called to order at 6:49 p.m. by President Melony Ford on Monday, December 9, 2013 in the administration office. Board members present: Ted Bonner, Laura Clark, Melony Ford, Mike Parker, Paul Noesser, and Richard Snell. Members absent: Carl McGill. Others in attendance: Superintendent Billy Lee, Jeffrey Steed and Lisa Doss. See attached for others present. Prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance were said during the special board meeting immediately preceding the regular meeting.

Paul Noesser motioned to approve the minutes of the November meeting as read. Motion passed with a 6-0 vote.

Melony Ford motioned to approve the financial report. Motion passed with a 6-0 vote.

President Melony Ford called for an executive session at 6:52 p.m. Board member Carl McGill arrived at 6:56 p.m. The meeting reconvened at 7:18 p.m.

Paul Noesser made a motion to accept the coaching letter of resignation of Jeremy Banister. Upon his request he was removed from girls' athletics and reassigned for the remainder of the school year. Motion passed with a 7-0 vote.

Paul Noesser motioned to accept a board resolution to approve the filing of the district master plan by Gene Hawk. Motion passed with a 7-0 vote.

Melony Ford motioned to purchase two used school buses from American Bus Sales for \$135,900. Motion passed with a 7-0 vote.

Paul Noesser motioned to purchase a new Bluebird school bus from Central Bus Sales for \$91,145. Motion passed with a 7-0 vote.

Richard Snell motioned to purchase an air conditioning unit for \$3520 from Greenlee. Motion passed with a 7-0 vote.

Melony Ford motioned to accept a bid from Glen Young Construction for \$5200 for concrete drainage, headwalls and sidewalks on campus. Motion passed with a 7-0 vote.

Ted Bonner motioned to accept a bid from Delight Hardware for \$6921.56 for a new metal roof on softball and baseball batting cages. Motion passed with a 7-0 vote.

Melony Ford motioned to accept scrapping or selling a school truck and buses 12 and 19 for a minimum of \$1000 each. Motion passed with a vote of 7-0.
