Richard Snell motioned to approve the purchase of two high school classroom cabinets to be built by John Stallsworth using the most economical materials available. Motion passed with a 6-0 vote.

Board President Melony Ford called for an executive session at 7:40 p.m. The meeting resumed at 8:32 p.m.

Ted Bonner motioned to purchase turf for the baseball batting cage from On Deck for \$2376.37. Motion passed with a 5-0 vote (board member Richard Snell was not present).
